A non-refundable, **cash only \$10** registration fee is charged for all High School Diploma classes. In addition, if a student stops attending and wishes to re-register, there is a \$10 cash only fee. For August registrations, the fee will be collected the day of registration. CAHSEE TEST PREPARATION

After meeting with advisor, students are placed in a class to review academic skills needed to pass the California High School Exit Exam (CAHSEE).

CAHSEE TEST DATES

Dec 4 & 11 SATURDAY May 10 & 11 TUE/WED

Students must attend the Registration/Assessment, Orientation, and first class meeting to complete registration. If a student misses any one of the above dates, they will have to start the registration process again and pay the non-refundable registration fee again.
